Outline of the resolutions ‘Healthy Food Pledge’, ‘Marketing of Breast-Milk Substitutes’ and ‘Destruction of the Remaining Smallpox Virus’

The three resolutions, passed by the WFPHA General Assembly, were published in the period between 1981 and 2008 under the heading ‘**diverse**’. The outline of the resolutions as follows:

The active role of the WFPHA in recognition of the sanitary, nutritional, and immunological benefits of breastfeeding for the health of human infants, and identifying circumstances in which substitutionary or supplemental nutrition may be required (*Marketing of Breast-Milk Substitutes, 1981*).

The WFPHA call for closure of these remaining laboratories after last cases of smallpox occurring in the world resulted from a laboratory mishap that led to extensive and expensive measures to prevent further infection, morbidity, and mortality (*Destruction of the Remaining Smallpox Virus, 1995*).

Improving local access to locally grown, sustainable, healthy food and value-added products and increasing public awareness by influencing industrial agricultures, feeding of industrial livestock, use of manure from concentrated animal feeding operations (CAFOs) and food purchasing decisions made by health care institutions (*Healthy Food Pledge, 2008*).
